Miss Irmgard Wentzel



For all these reasons, and for all that she has given of herself to us, we the Class of '66 dedicate the Maroon and White to Miss Irmgard Wentzel.





Continuing an active interest in basketball from his high school and college days, Mr. Elliott coached our basketball teams for twenty-four years, including 1952's undefeated championship team.



May we part, Ralph Elliott, by wishing you and your lovely wife, Fran, the best of fruitful retirements.









The Dramatics Club is an organization for student activity in play presentation and in appreciation of the drama. It offers these opportunities to the whole of the high school's student body.



The Sophomore social event of the year was the Winter Wipe-out held in conjunction with the Freshman Class.






Approximately 403 seniors this year wholeheartedly agree that the Class of '66 has come through again.
















Bob,Treece
