# DEDICATION



# WORK EXPERIENCE



Work Experience, under the direction of Mr. Larry Swenson, has assumed an important role in the lives of some 75 Bay Shore students. These students, besides carrying their regular class loads, work a twenty to thirty hour week in local business and industry. They receive one-half credit toward graduation for every three hundred hours that they work, with a maximum of one credit per year.



Explosive Wayne Huff was well on his way toward repeating as Suffolk County's high scorer, when a knee injury forced him to the sideline midway in the season.





Bay Shore's contributions to the All-League Team








## SENIOR CLASS
