
All of us who came into close contact with Mr. Jones saw what king of person he is. He's hard working, but never loses his sense of humor. He is a great guy to work with.


The Tides

The Student-Faculty Senate has begun getting students interested in their school, and doing their part to bring back school spirit.










BOCES is a wonderful experience for students who are interested in a particular skill. It provides an opportunity to learn a trade.


Flute Choir
