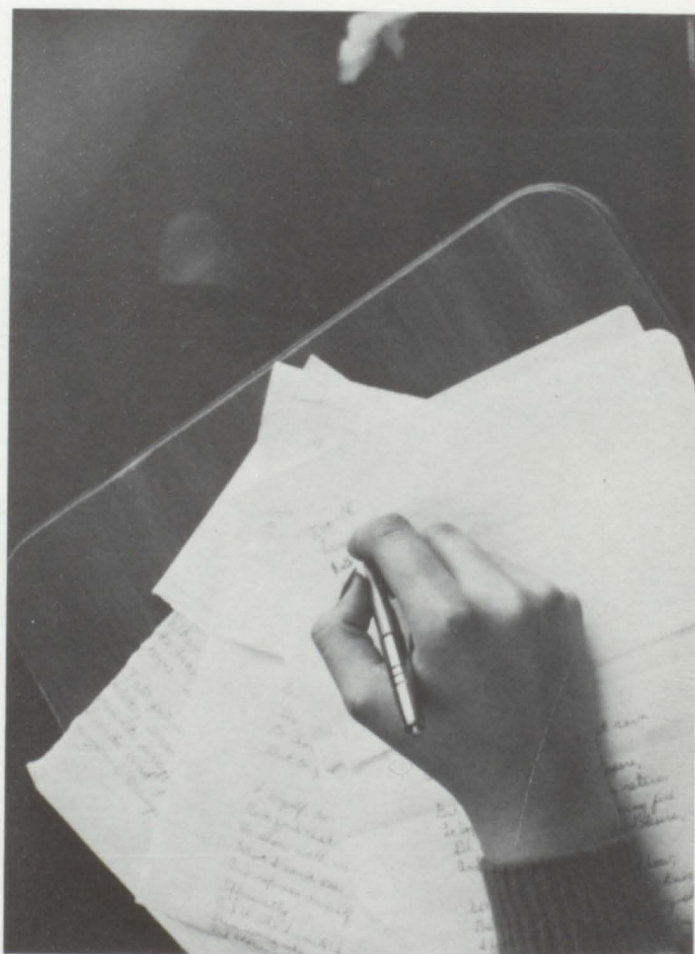
Reflections

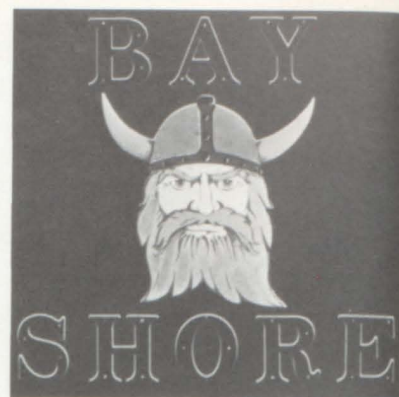

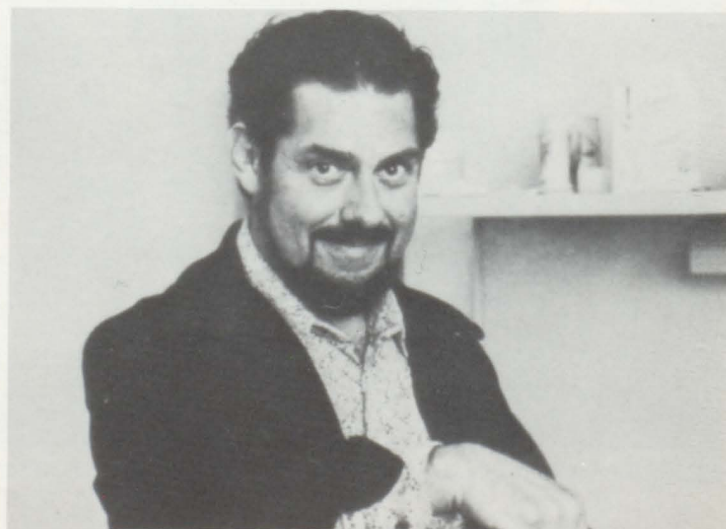
Backstage Club

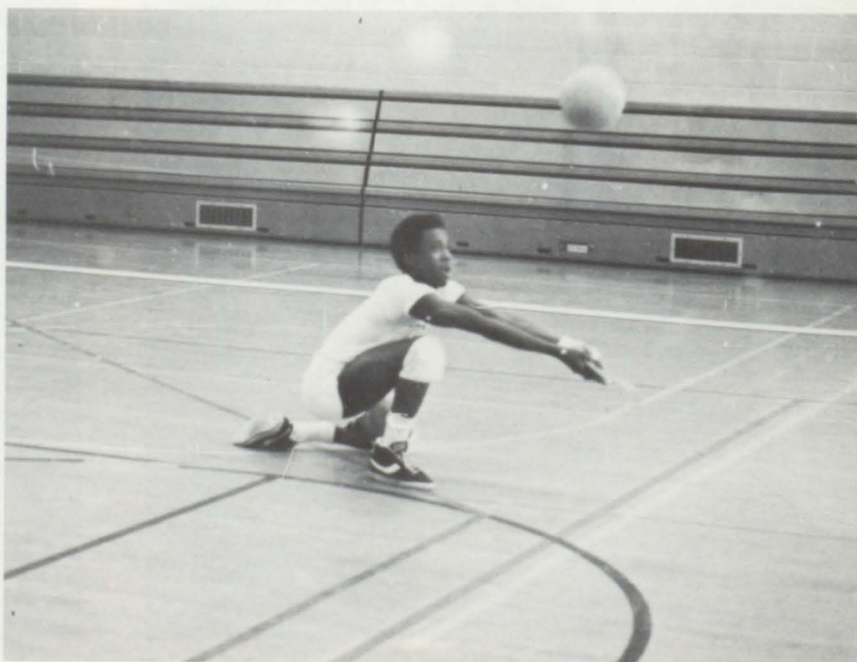
BENJI OYOLA

The week's excitement and goodwill were felt by the entire student body.



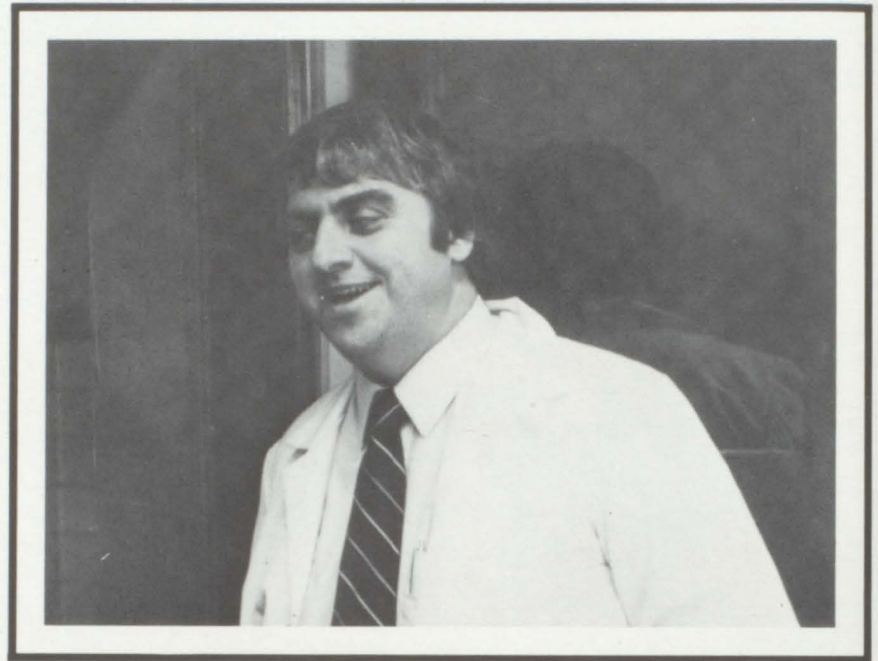
The Dedication
