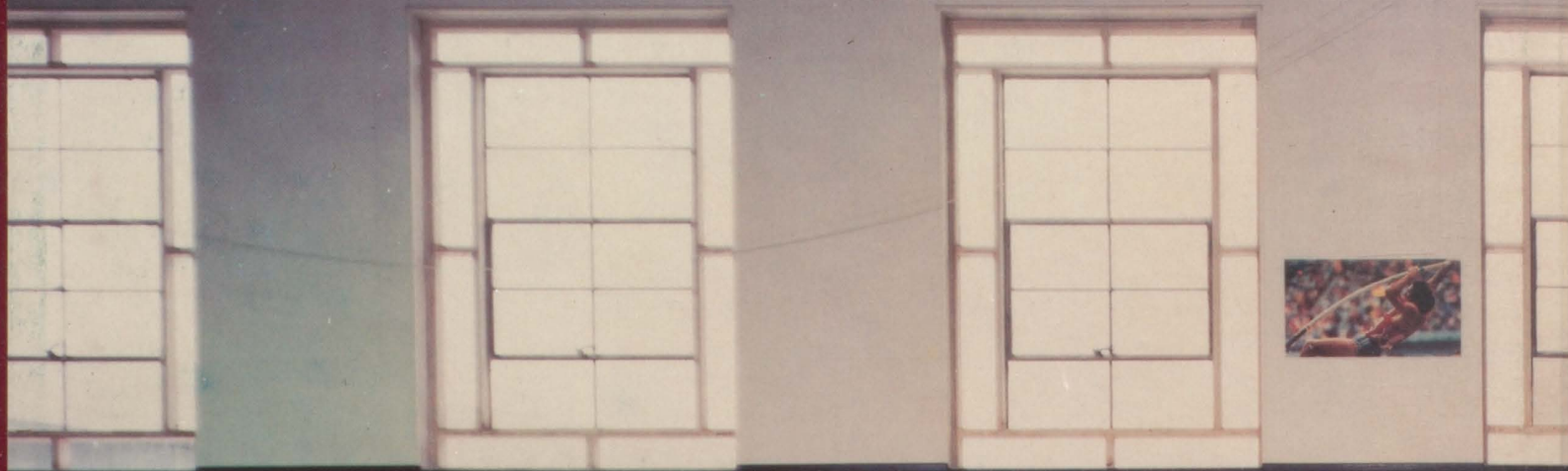


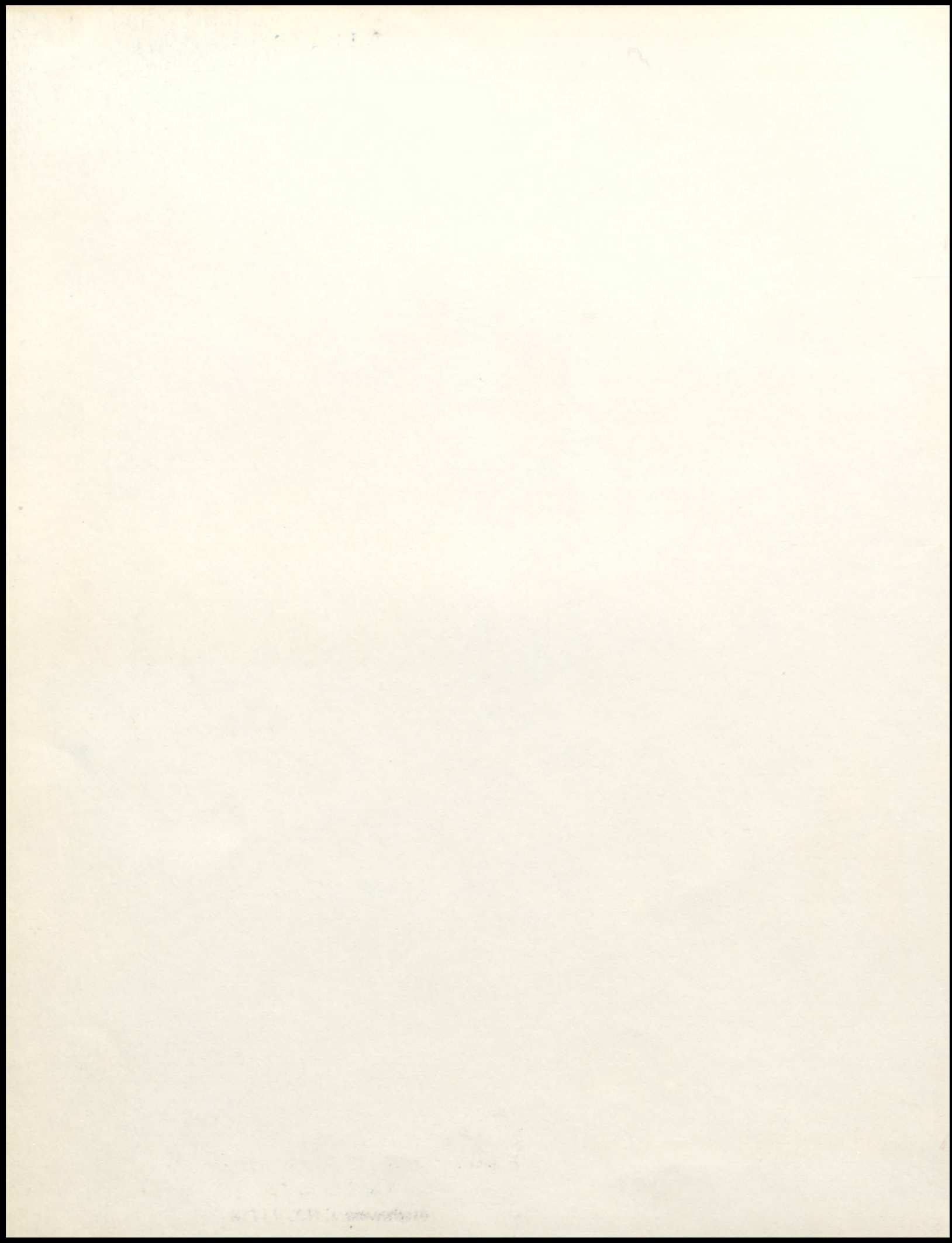

A Glimpse of Old Bay Shore

Let us imagine that we are taking a horse and buggy ride along South Country Road during the so-called "gay ninety" era. It is a fine, typical summer's day. Just right for a nice, short drive down the shady countryside. Bay Shore is already a young fast growing summer resort, one of the most famous neighborhoods in America for its unusual beauty. As we roll down the old country road, comfortably sitting in our tandem rig, I will point out a few points of interest along the way, and give you several facts worth knowing about old Bay Shore.

A bicycle path which borders the road is frequently used, and here and there you can see high wheeled cyclists passing by. It takes no little amount of practice to handle one of these things. The big wheel in front accompanied by a small wheel in the back makes it awkward to ride. The wide spreading trees and elegant country estates show us why this part of Long Island is renowned for its beauty.

There are many places of amusement in this little community. Over there on Fourth Avenue, you can catch a glimpse of a roller skating rink. It is run by a carpenter who built the place himself. Many a skating party, homeward bound, will stop at the ice cream shop of "Perry's" at the north-west corner of Main Street and Fourth Avenue for some refreshments.

If golf is your sport, we can journey down to the Bay Shore Golf Links and spend an enjoyable afternoon there, chasing the little white ball up and down the course. Horse racing is of course a popular pastime. Many horse-lovers will be found at the driving park at North Awixa Avenue and the Boulevard. I believe we'll take a little ride down to the Great South Bay which provides amusement for many seamed individuals. Sailing is a widely enjoyed pastime, and the excellent water sports create a lot of publicity for Bay Shore.

On both sides of the street we may see many large and attractive hotels,

an influencing factor in Bay Shore's role as a summer resort. The Dominy House, established in 1861 on Main Street at North Bay Shore Avenue, entertained many distinguished guests, including President Chester A. Arthur. The Prospect House, an immense summer hotel on Ocean Avenue, provides every possible comfort for vacationists. The Linwood Hotel on South Clinton Avenue has wide porches, which provide a view of spacious lawns and tree-lined avenues around it. These are just a few of the many busy hotels which dot the countryside.

While Bay Shore enjoys great popularity as a summer resort, it is also a busy little industrial town. Fishing is a chief industry. A helpful influence in the growth of Bay Shore has been its numerous creeks, which furnish ideal mooring places for boats. Believe it or not the capture of big turtles in the ocean off Fire Island Inlet is nothing new to persons living in the vicinity. Many large loggerhead and rubberback turtles have been taken, many of them weighing over half a ton.

Here we are at the Maple Avenue Docks. The oyster industry is a flourishing business here. In a single season from October to February shipments of one company alone amount to about 75,000 bushels. From here oysters are shipped all over the country, even to places west of the Mississippi valley. Yes, it seems that the nation depends a lot on little Bay Shore for its oysters.

As our rig takes us on down the road, we notice an old grain mill on East Main Street. Let us glance at the mill. It is a one-story building with an attic. One part of the structure contains equipment, while the other part is a residence occupied by the miller. The farmers who bring their wheat and corn to be ground, pay the miller by letting him keep part of the flour.

We are off again on our drive, but we soon have to stop to let a herd of swine cross the road. This reminds us that livestock (mostly pigs) is another chief industry. The pigs are given full freedom to run at large anywhere.

Bay Shore was not always known by that name. Mechanicsville was the earliest title given to this little settlement. However, that name didn't last long because another place upstate was already so named. At a meeting in 1849 the residents agreed to rename it Penataquit, in honor of an Indian tribe which made its home in the vicinity. At a special meeting in 1868, a simpler and more attractive name was thought advisable. The name Bay Shore was suggested and adopted.

It has been known as Bay Shore ever since.

We are nearing the end of our little ride. So I'll stop the horses and let you out of the rig. However, I have but touched the surface of Bay Shore's unique history. Perhaps some day we may get together again and I'll tell you a little more about Suffolk County's fastest growing village.

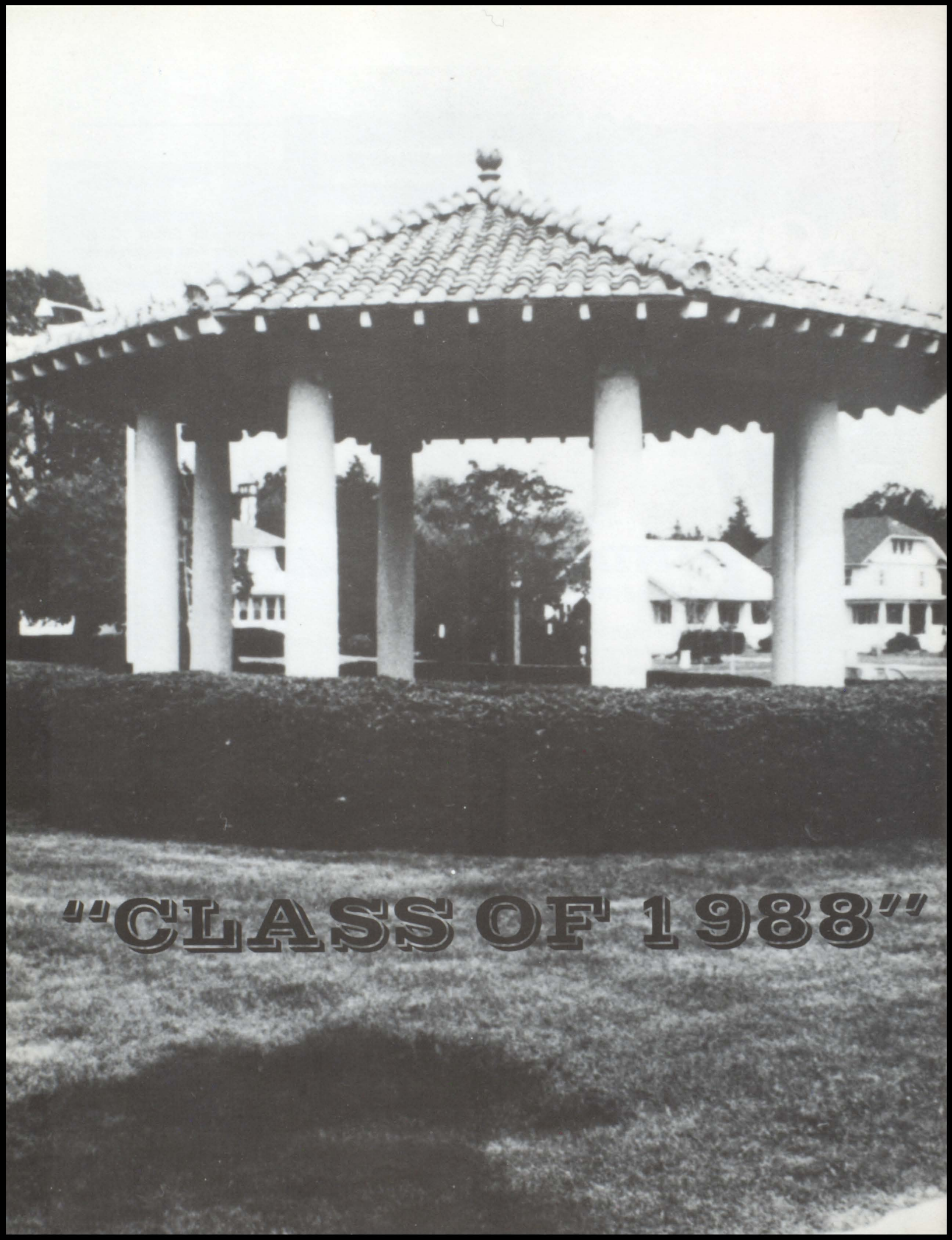


Mr. Thomas Howard

By the way, the Yearbook Staff has it from reliable sources that the girls were indeed victorious.

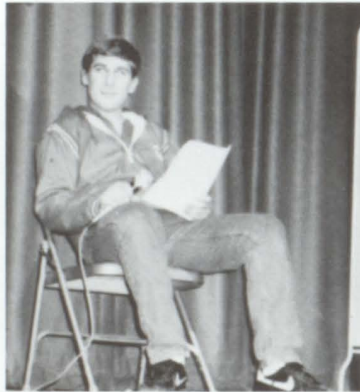

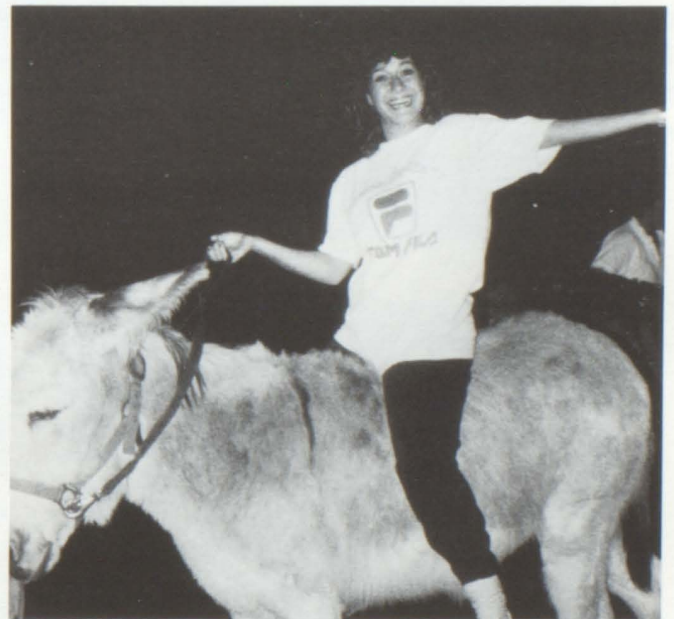
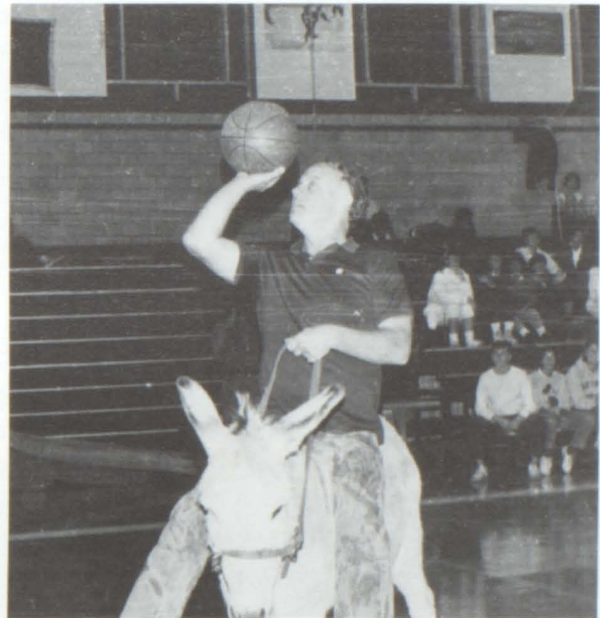


Donkey Basketball

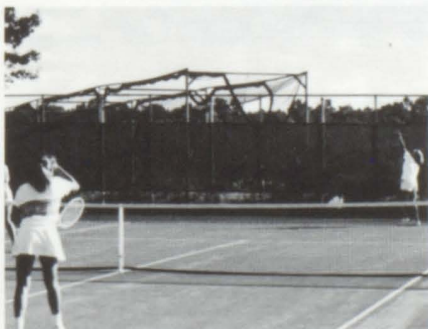
Bay Shore sent nine individual competitors to the Conference II tournament, eventually leaving three eligible for the county individual tournament.
