Fireside Book Discussion

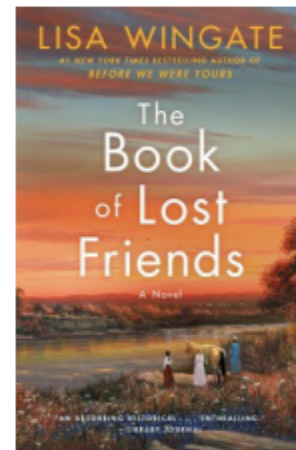

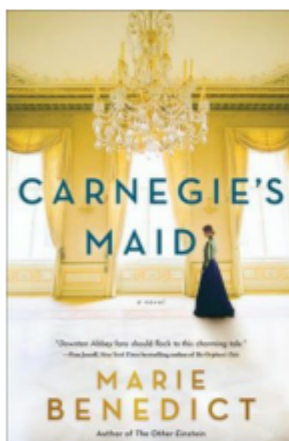
The Book of Lost Friends : a novel
